### " Then and Now" John 14:23-29

Jesus is speaking to his disciples about his departure. They are rightly concerned about their future and have very little notion of what it holds without him. What will become of them? Jesus tells them not to let their hearts be troubled. How can they

possibly hear that? They are filled with predictable confusion and anxiety. Nevertheless, Jesus casts a vision for them deep into the future. So he is also speaking to us, today--the same truth but from a different perspective. We have two millennia of witness in the Church to build upon. Even in our darkest moments, we have the testimony of the saints about the indwelling of the Holy Spirit. We know the sacrifices that have been made by the community that Jesus promises will grow up around God's love. It is important to remember that the Church did not spring up out of nothing. These few verses give us the blueprint for the very architect of the faith.
