Acts 16:16-34

From Your Priest:



"Jesus at Prayer" John 17:20-26

Jesus is found at prayer in what is known as the Final Discourse in John's Gospel. He is not on the campaign trail giving speeches, not on the hustings, not trying to sell anything to anybody. Instead, He is deep in prayer for his disciples—for

you and me, and everyone who seeks to follow him. He is praying for the future of the Church in every epoch of its long story. What is the substance of Jesus' final prayer? It is unity. Oneness. He and God the Father are one, Jesus is in the Father and the Father is in Jesus. He tells it like it is: he has loved his disciples (and us) even as God has loved him. What is his prayerful hope, his intention? It is that the world will know God by the love of Christ that is in each of us. As Christian people, we often come to Jesus with our laundry list of wants and needs. How often do we consider his prayer for us, for the Church, and ask ourselves how we are doing with respect to fulfilling it?


