"Barn Building"
Luke 12:13-21

We get some high drama in our Gospel lesson from Luke this week. Things seem to be going pretty well for the farmer in the story. Abundance, good fortune, the good life. His biggest problem is where to store

up all his grain (and gain). The solution appears to lie in building bigger barns, making more room for his wealth. In the meantime, what is not to enjoy? It's all about squeezing the most out of life, right? (And what could possibly go wrong?) God apparently has other plans. God sort of stages an intervention of the most serious kind. The game is up! Tonight! All that barn-building, all that effort to make more room for more and more and more. What happens next? Who gets all that stuff? The question, as ever, is what our life is all about, and who is in control.


