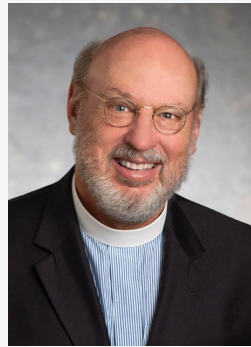

From Your Priest:



"Now That's Pretty Hard"

Luke 14:25-33

Jesus is saying things that are hard for us to hear (and preachers to preach on!). Surrounded by crowds, and the popularity and success they implied, Jesus must have seen clearly the gulf between the human and the divine. He knows that what is often important to us—success and possessions for example, are not what is important to God and his redeeming work in his Son, the Christ. He issues a warning and it echoes across the centuries in the Church. Nobody in the Church, no disciple of Christ gets a pass. It is hard to hear about, this radical discontinuity between God and the human condition, a very hard lesson to absorb. Yet that is what Jesus has come to tell us, to show us, and to offer himself for us. He does not just talk. He walks the walk. Sometimes, it makes me tremble.

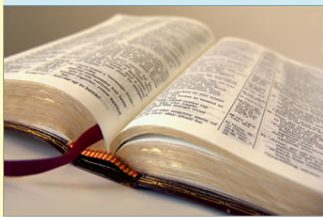
