"Stewards" Luke 16:1-13

Jesus constantly invokes the image of the steward. The steward is the one who manages, who looks after, who supervises, who takes care of. This is a constant reminder—especially for us—that we have

been given so much, and we have been provided for, even when we fail to grasp it (or want even more). I'm reminded of this every Sunday morning when I turn the lights on and say my prayers in the sanctuary. I feel surrounded by the five generations who have worshipped at St Mary's and who met challenges in their day. None of this happened by accident. No way. How do we rejoice in all that has been provided? How does it show up in our attitude as those who are called as stewards in many capacities?
