## From Your Priest:



"Are You a Saint?"
Luke 6:20-31

Sainthood is often confused with perfection. If you think saints are perfect, you might read the bible more often. All saints are human, all are sinners, and all are dependent on God's mercy and

redemption in Christ. We are given a shot at sainthood every day—every time we offer our confession, receive absolution, and emerge strengthened in our faith. (Our sacramental life is not just for solace, but also for strength.) Jesus gives us all sorts of models of holiness, the very heart of sainthood, in the Beatitudes. Christ tells us the ways we blessed but do not always recognize it. There are saints everywhere, each of us in Christ's own flock. Thank goodness sainthood has nothing to do with perfection.
