"The Great Messenger"
Matthew 11:2-11

Jesus tells us that John is more than a prophet. He plays the most crucial role in the advent of the Messiah, the Christ. John is the ultimate messenger preparing the way for God's decisive intervention in

human life. If he is God's great messenger, as Jesus says he is, it might be good to hear his message. He practices what he preaches, a deep humility. It must have been tempting for him to exaggerate his stature—he was like a rock star—but he understands his role. He is to point to the light; he is not the light. His own testimony and suffering make him remarkable for the ages. In the quiet of the Advent season, may we find our place in his image. Preparing for the coming of Christ is a serious business.
