"A Great Commission"
Matthew 28:16-20

Jesus makes an impressive statement as he prepares to ascend back to eternity. He tells his disciples to make disciples of everyone, and to baptize in the name of one God in three persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Strong action verbs—"to make" and "to baptize." The Church then moves into the future in action to proclaim God's revelation of love.

God has revealed that love by what we call the Holy Trinity, the Godhead of unity in three persons. The household of God is not something that may be reduced to an easy understanding. It is too beautiful to be readily grasped, and God's love dwarfs the human imagination. That said, we are deeply blessed by a God who shows divine identity to us, and who goes to such lengths for all that God has made.
