Note from Rev. Susie

Every time there is a tragic event in the news, I, like other religious leaders, struggle to speak about the event and what it means for our congregation. I hope to respond in a way that enables us to grieve and grow and respond faithfully to our calling as God's body in the world. The deaths of 9 African American Christians, in worship and study together at church, who died in an irrational act of hatred, brings closer to us the threat that Christians often live under in other parts of the world. It also highlights painfully, how irrationally hostile some tortured individuals can be. Our brothers and sisters in Christ suffer at times in ways that we do not realize, both here in this country and in other parts of the world.

We tend to assume that we can worship in safety in the U.S. As we move toward the 4th of July, and the celebration of our independence of a nation, the freedom to worship God as we wish is a precious thing. Please pray for the church in the world. For those who must worship in secret, for those who are all too familiar with being martyrs, for those whom practicing their faith puts them in conflict with the law of the land.
